

Saving pre-existing Garmin favourites on your PC

Smoothline GPS files contain many stage start and finish locations. Managing each point individually would be a tedious process, thus we provide instructions for installing and removing “favourites” en-mass.

If you have “favourites” stored in your Garmin GPS that you wish to retain, this process will allow you to save them to your PC before adding/removing Smoothline points.

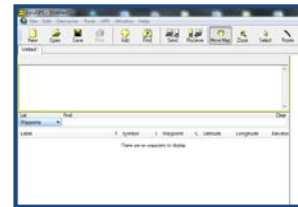


Saving pre-existing favourites

Saving pre-existing favourites to your PC requires you to download a free program, “Easy GPS”. This program will allow you to combine the favourites you wish to keep as a single file saved on your PC.

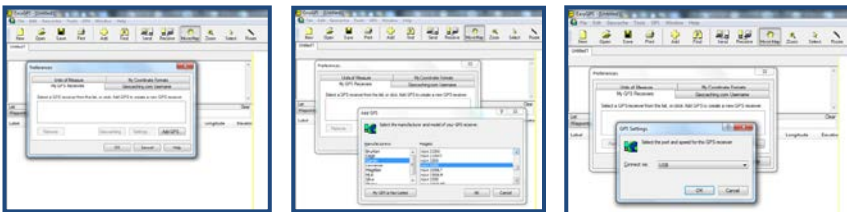
- 1) Download the Easy GPS program.
(free download from www.easygps.com)

- 2) Open Easy GPS program.



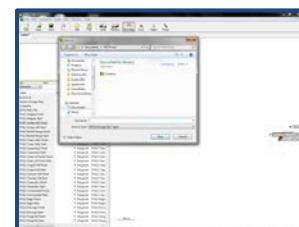
- 3) Add your Garmin GPS details.

Edit > Preferences > My GPS Receivers > Add GPS



- 4) [In EasyGPS] Download the favourites stored your Garmin
Receive > [select the appropriate Garmin GPS] > OK

- 5) [In EasyGPS] Save your previous favourites on your PC:
Save > [set file name and location on your PC] > OK



Your pre-existing “favourites” have now been saved as a .GPX file on your PC and you are safe to “delete all” when removing points following an event.

To re-install your pre-existing favourites on your Garmin GPS, simply follow the instructions on the [resources page](#) of our website as though they were a Smoothline GPS file.
